Now in its third year, Workwise has three employment consultants / kairapu tūranga mahi integrated with The People's Project Hamilton and Tauranga teams, delivering employment support as a seamless part of The People's Project service.

We believe that people shouldn't have to put their employment dreams on hold because of homelessness. Having a paid job can help with preventing homelessness, increasing self-sufficiency and community integration. It also brings health and wellbeing, financial security, an increased sense of citizenship and can lead to a decrease in negative social impacts.


Offering employment support as an integral part of other health and social supports is therefore crucial.

We are pleased to share our annual results achieved by Workwise working alongside The People's Project during the past year.
