*Mā te kōrero, mā te mōhio, ka mārama.*

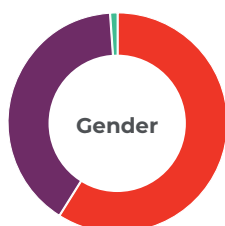
*Through discussion and sharing of knowledge, comes understanding.*

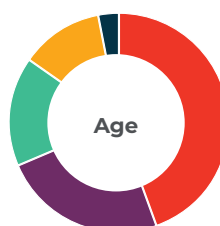
This year, we worked with **1,607 new people** - helping them to find work, and to stay in work.
